ARTICLE I: NAME AND CORPORATE IDENTIFICATION (Current)

The name of this organization shall be the GOVERNMENT FINANCE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION OF CONNECTICUT, INC. (The "Corporation"). The Corporation is incorporated under the Connecticut State Statutes and is an authorized 501 (c) 6 organization under the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE I: NAME, PURPOSE AND CORPORATE IDENTIFICATION (Revised)

Section 1 Name:

The name of this organization shall be the GOVERNMENT FINANCE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION OF CONNECTICUT, INC. (The "Corporation").

Section 2 Purpose:

The purpose of this Corporation shall be:

1. To promote the use of appropriate financial management and accounting standards by governmental organizations within the State of Connecticut;
2. To provide educational opportunities and programs which will aid in the professional development of individual members;
3. To provide a forum for the sharing of information, views, analysis of financial matters and membership networking opportunities;
4. To promote legislation supporting general principles of economy and efficiency in governmental administration;
5. To cooperate with the Government Finance Officers' Association of the United States and Canada, the New England States Government Finance Officers Association and other organizations established with similar goals;
6. To engage in all other activities as may be necessary or desirable to foster the purpose of the Association.

Section 3 Incorporation:

The Corporation shall operate exclusively for educational and charitable purposes and is incorporated under the Connecticut State Statutes and is an authorized 501 (c) 6 organization under the Internal Revenue Code.
